# Zero Trust Principles / Concepts / Assertions

- **Never Trust, Always Verify** – All users and devices are treated as untrusted. Every device, user, application/workload and data flow is authenticated and explicitly authorized to the **least privilege** required using dynamic security policies.
- **Assume Breach** – Consciously operate and defend resources with the assumption that an adversary has presence within your environment. Deny by default, heavily scrutinize requests for access, users, devices and data flows. All traffic is logged and inspected.
- **Verify Explicitly** – All resources are **consistently** accessed in a secure manner using multiple attributes (dynamic and static) to derive confidence levels for contextual access to resources.
